The guidelines must be met or else the article publication may be rejected for not observing the appropriate Springer Nature Editor layout.

#### 1st - Title

Font: Times New Roman

Style: BoldSize: 14

#### 2nd - Authors

Font: Times New Roman

#### **Notes:**

- The authors must be numbered according to their respective institutions. E.g., if all authors are from the same institution, all of them will be numbered with the number 1.
- All authors must provide the ORCID ID. If any of the authors do not have an ORCID account, it will be necessary to sign up on the official ORCID website. (<a href="https://orcid.org/">https://orcid.org/</a>).
- The corresponding institution number and the ORCID ID must be written in superscript mode immediately after each author name.

#### 3rd - Institutions

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment: Centered
- Spacing:
  - Before: 0ptAfter: 10pt
  - o Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cmSpecial: None

### **Notes:**

• The institutions must be presented in accordance with the following standard: "institution name", "City", "Country".

#### 4th - Emails

- Font: CourierStyle: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment: Centered
- Spacing:
  - Before: 0ptAfter: 10pt
  - o Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cm

• All authors' emails must be inserted below the respective institutions.

#### 5th - Abstract

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment: Justified
- Spacing:
  - Before: 30ptAfter: 0pt
  - o Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 1cmRight: 1cmSpecial: None

#### Notes:

• The abstract must start with the word "Abstract." with bold font.

# 6th - Keywords

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment: Left
- Spacing:
  - Before: 11ptAfter: 18pt
  - o Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 1cmRight: 1cmSpecial: None

#### Notes:

• The keywords must start with the word "Keywords:" in bold font.

## 7th - Section titles (Level 1)

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Bold

- Size: 12
- Alignment: Left
- Spacing:
  - Before: 18ptAfter: 12pt
  - Line spacing: At least 15pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cm
  - Special: Hanging 1cm

#### **Notes:**

• All sections must be numbered, except Acknowledgments and References.

## 8th - Section titles (Level 2)

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Bold
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Left
- Spacing:
  - o Before (after text body): 18pt
  - o Before (immediately after a level 1 title): Opt
  - o After: 8pt
  - Line spacing: At least 12pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cm
  - Special: Hanging 1cm

# 9th - Section titles (Level 3)

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Bold
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Justfied (the title remains in the text body, separated by a dot)
- Spacing:
  - Before (after text body): 18pt
  - o Before (immediately after a level 2 title): Opt
  - o After: Opt
  - o Line spacing: At least 12pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cmSpecial: None

# 10th - Section titles (Level 4)

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: ItalicSize: 10
- Alignment: Justfied (the title remains in the text body, separated by a dot)
- Spacing:
  - Before: 12ptAfter: 0pt
  - Line spacing: At least 12pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cmSpecial: None

#### 11th - Text

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Justfied
- Spacing:
  - Before: 0ptAfter: 0pt
  - o Line spacing: At least 12pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0cmRight: 0cmSpecial:
    - 1st paragraph of each section: None
    - Other paragraphs: First line 0.4cm

# 12th - Figures and Tables

- All Figures and Tables must be mentioned in the article following the numbers in their respective titles.
- All Figures and Tables must have a good resolution, and the Tables must not be inserted as Figures.
- The Figures and Tables must be centered in the article.

# 13th - Figures and tables titles

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment (if the title has just one line): Centered
- Alignment (if the title has more than one line): Justified

- Spacing:
  - Before (figure title): 6pt
     Before (table title): 12pt
     After (figure title): 12pt
     After (table title): 6pt
     Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:

Left: 0cmRight: 0cmSpecial: None

#### Notes:

- The figures' titles must be placed below the figures.
- The tables' titles must be placed above the tables.
- The numbers of the figures and tables must be written in bold font before their titles.

## 14th - Equations

- All Equations must be mentioned in the article following their respective numbers.
- All elements within the Equations (variables and constants) must be described in the text body.
- The Equations must be centered in the article, and their numbers must be aligned to the right.

## 15th - References

- Font: Times New Roman
- Style: Regular
- Size: 9
- Alignment: Justified
- Spacing:
  - Before: 0ptAfter: 0pt
  - Line spacing: At least 11pt
- Indentation:
  - Left: 0.4cmRight: 0cm
  - Special: Hanging 0.2cm

#### Notes:

- All references must be numerically listed in the last section of the article in the same order they are cited in the text.
- The references format must follow the Springer Editor standard, according to the templates presented in the following file:

#### 16th - General Recommendations

- We recommend the authors use the Mendeley software Editor (https://www.mendeley.com/) with Springer style (https://www.zotero.org/styles/springer-basic-author-date-no-et-al-with-issue) help to format the academic references.
- We recommend the authors use the Grammarly platform (<a href="https://www.grammarly.com/">https://www.grammarly.com/</a>) to correct spelling and grammatical errors in the English language.
- We request the authors to avoid using companies' names in the article unless the company manager previously approves the use of the name. In the case of the use of a company name, BTSym'24 Editorial Committee will request the appropriate documentation.
